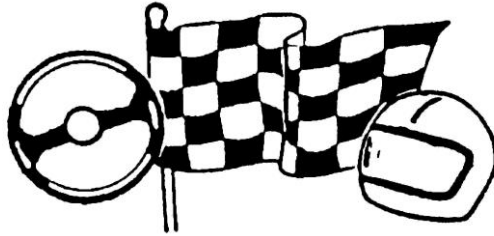

The COMPETITION DRIVERS CLUB was formed about 1971 by a group of competitors (and ex-competitors) who saw a need for the establishment of a club, separate from the WASCC that could represent and cater specifically for the needs of drivers at Wanneroo.

The CDC began with two main objectives, (1) to provide a voice for drivers within CAMS at its State Council meeting, (2) to purchase enhanced fire/safety and rescue equipment for use at the race track. The vehicles boast Fire and Safety Equipment along with sophisticated foam generation and Jaws of Life apparatus.

In 2014 because there was so much racing now at Collie Motorplex the Competition Drivers Club decided to donate one of its Holden Rodeo Fire Utes to the Collie fire crew as an extra precaution against the ever presence chance of a race car fire and to protect the drivers.

It would be remiss of us not to thank all Fire Marshals who not only come to Wanneroo but also get asked to go to events like the Melbourne Grand Prix, Bathurst and Clipsal. This is why we in the West can proudly boast to having one of, if not the best Fire Crew in Australia.
