Appendix D - 2017 CAMS WA Saloon Car Championship

D1 ELIGIBILITY

(i) The objective for the 2017 Saloon Car Championship (the CAMS state Championship) shall be to provide a competitive and exciting racing category for Production based Type 3 vehicles. The Championship of races are open to all drivers who hold the minimum of a CAMS PCC licence and whose vehicles comply with this Appendix and with the requirements outlined in the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motorsport: - Group 3K - Saloon Cars

(ii) There shall be two separate state championships for Saloon cars

Class A CAMS 3K AU/VT/VY/BA cars

Class B CAMS 3K EA/VN cars

Any other cars will be on invitation by the category organisers only, and will not be eligible for Championship points

D2 CATEGORY ORGANISERS

(i) The organisers of the championship shall be the Saloon Car Racing Association of WA, herein referred to as "the Organisers" WA saloon car Committee: salooncars@hotmail.com

(ii) Category Manager (CM) Saloon Car Racing Association of WA appointment

D 3 GRID DETERMINATION

The grid for each race shall be determined as follows:

Barbagallo Raceway

Race 1: The grid for race 1 shall be split between Class A, AU/VT/VY/BA first, an empty row, then Class B EA/VN.

Race 2: The grid for race 2 shall be split between Class A, AU/VT/VY/BA first, an empty row, then Class B EA/VN.

Race 3: The grid for race 3 shall be split between the Class A, AU/VT/VY/BA first, an empty row, then Class B EA/VN, except the top 50% from both Classes will be reversed for race 3

Collie Motorplex

All Races: The grid for all 3 races per meeting shall be Progressive Grid as per CAMS R.M.S.R.

D4 START PROCEDURE

Barbagallo Raceway

The start procedure for each race will be as detailed in the RMSR, **But with a 10 second Handicap between Class A and Class B.** The start of the race for **Class A** shall be at the extinguishing of the red light. An official shall be holding a yellow flag above his head behind **Class A**, but ahead of **Class B**, and shall move away approximately 2 seconds after **Class A** has moved away. The starter shall signify the start of **Class B** by re turning on the red light and extinguishing the red light after a delay of 10 to 12 seconds from the start of **Class A**.

Collie Motorplex

The start procedure for each race will be as detailed in the RMSR, Normal starting procedure.

D 5 AUTOMOBILE MARKINGS

Each automobile must display the following Series markings, appropriately attached and Positioned as detailed below at all times during each round of the Series.

The Series Markings will be provided by the Category Manager.

- Front windscreen strip=Sponsor Name (upper portion of front windscreen)
- Rear windscreen strip=Sub-sponsor Name
- Number Plate=Rightway Industries
- Front guards both sides=Tyre Supplier
- A Pedders Suspension decal on each rear mudguard
- A space must be left above the car number for round sponsorship

D6 DRIVING STANDARDS OBSERVERS D.S.O.

A D.S.O. may be appointed by the Category Manager.

D7 ELIGIBILITY OFFICERS E.O.

D8 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- (i) Two way radio communication between automobile and pit is permitted
- (ii) The installation of any antenna for radio communication is subject to the approval of the Chief Scrutineer

Only the 1st 3 races run to correct regulations per meeting will be for Championship points.
