



Appendix F - 2017 CAMS WA SPORTS CAR CHAMPIONSHIP

I.1 CHAMPIONSHIP NAMING

The championship shall be officially known as the "2017 CAMS WA Sports Car Championship".

I.2 CATEGORY ORGANISERS

The organisers of the championships shall be the WA Sports Sedan and Sports Car Association Inc (WASSSCA)

I.3 CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY

The championship shall be a series of races open to all competitors with log booked vehicles who present their vehicle to compete in compliance with CAMS 2nd category.

The onus of proof of vehicle eligibility rests with each individual competitor. The organisers of each category shall determine eligibility and designate which category and which championship each vehicle is competing for prior to the commencement of each race meeting.

I.4 COMPETITION NUMBERS

The category organisers are responsible for issuing competition numbers within each group to minimise duplication between all competitors.

I.5 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Vehicles must comply with the General Requirements of Automobiles (as applicable) in schedules A, B and C of the CAMS Manual.

I.6 RACE FORMAT

The race format shall be as prescribed for Sprint races in the approved standing race regulations for each circuit.

I.7 POINT SCORE

Points will be awarded for placegetters within each category in each race. The championship shall be won by the driver accumulating the highest number of points throughout the series.

I.8 CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY OFFICERS

The Category eligibility officers will be appointed by the category organisers. Interim or substitute. category eligibility officers may be added at any time by the category organisers.

I.9 DRIVING STANDARDS OBSERVERS

The driving standards observers will be appointed by the category organisers. Interim or substitute driving standard observers may be added at any time by the category organisers.
