



## **Appendix H 2017 CAMS WA Improved Production State Championships**

### **H.1 ELIGIBILITY**

(i) The 2017 WA over 3 litre, under 3000 litre, under 2 litre and under 1.6 litre' Improved Production Car Championships, hereinafter referred to as "the championship" shall be a series of races open to all drivers whose vehicles comply with the Improved Production Car (Group 3J) rules as defined by the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS).

(ii) The onus of proof of vehicle eligibility rests with the individual competitor at all times.

(iii) At the conclusion of championship races vehicles can expect to be directed to parc fermé without returning to the pits or paddock and without having been interfered with. Such vehicles shall remain under the control of the Chief Scrutineer.

(iv) Any competing car may be impounded at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer in accordance with the race meeting standing regulations.

(v) Inspections will be carried out by the nominated Official at a nominated time. The driver/entrant may request to have the examination carried out at an event. The owner/driver/entrant or team manager must be present at any inspection, as will be a technical officer of IPRWA whose contact details are found at [www.iprawa.net](http://www.iprawa.net)

### **H.2 CLASS DEFINITION**

#### **CLASS 1**

Improved Production Cars between 3001cc and 6000cc engine capacity shall be eligible to contest the Championship.

#### **CLASS 2**

Improved Production Cars between 2001cc and 3000cc engine capacity shall be eligible to contest the Championship.

#### **CLASS 3**

Improved Production Cars between 1601cc and 2000cc engine capacity shall be eligible to contest the Championship.

#### CLASS 4

Improved Production Cars of up to 1600 cc engine capacity shall be eligible to contest the Championship.

#### CLASS 5

Targa Cars will have their own championship and points. .  
Eligible cars are SS, LMS, and SR Classes and some other classes by application and acceptance by IPRAWA.  
Cars must comply to the CAMS manual and must be presented as if to a Targa event.

#### H.3 Organisers

The organisers of the championships shall be the Improved Production Racing Association of WA Inc., hereinafter referred to as "the organisers".

#### H.5 POINTSCORE

- (i) A driver can score points in different vehicles during the year subject to para E.1, however points will be awarded for the capacity class in which the individual vehicle falls.
- (ii) A driver may only score points in any one vehicle at any one event. That vehicle must have qualified for that event so that a driver may be able to score points. A driver may change vehicles after qualifying, race 1 or race 2 but no points will be scored.

##### COMPETITION NUMBERS

- (i) Where Championship classes run separately the numbers 1 shall be reserved. Where classes run combined the number 1 shall be reserved for the under 6000 cc class winner in 2016.

#### H.7

##### Starting Format for all races except the "Tander Cup"

First Race (8) Eight laps off Qualifying .

Race 2 (10) Ten Laps Reverse top 10 Competitors from race 1 ie person who finished 10th starts 1st Person who finished 9th starts second and so on and 11th onward as they finished race 1

Race 3 (8) Eight laps grid on combined points from race 1 and 2.

##### Tander Cup Starting Format

Race 1 (10) Ten Laps Starting off Qualified positions.

Race 2 (10) Ten Laps Full Reverse Grid off points from race 1 \*\*EXCLUDING DNF AND DNS these will be off the rear of the reverse grid.

Race 3 (15) Fifteen Laps Full Reverse Grid off points from race 1 and 2 \*\*EXCLUDING DNF AND DNS these will be off the rear of the reverse grid.

The Tander Cup winners are top 3 Over 2 Litres and Top 3 Under 2 Litres. With normal point scores for all classes.
